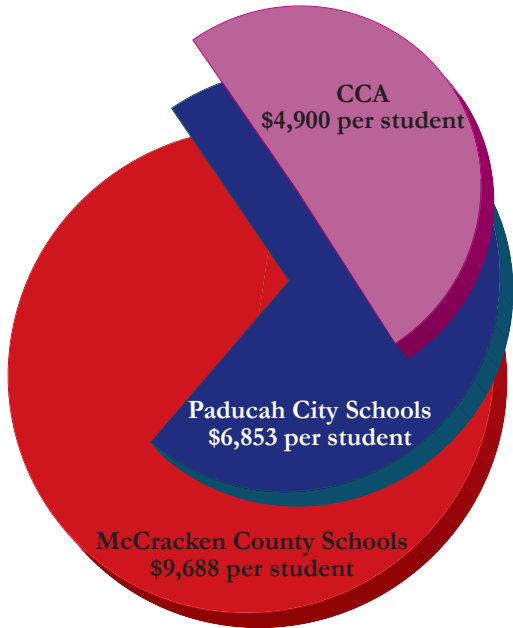
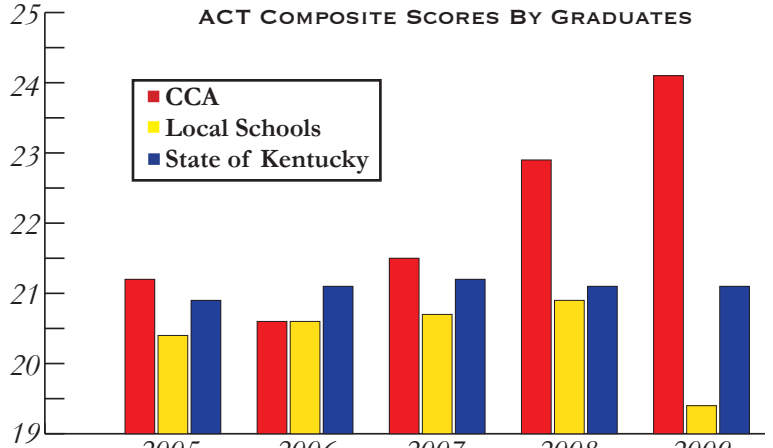


SPENDING LEVELS PER STUDENT BY SCHOOL SYSTEM

Academic Performance at CCA

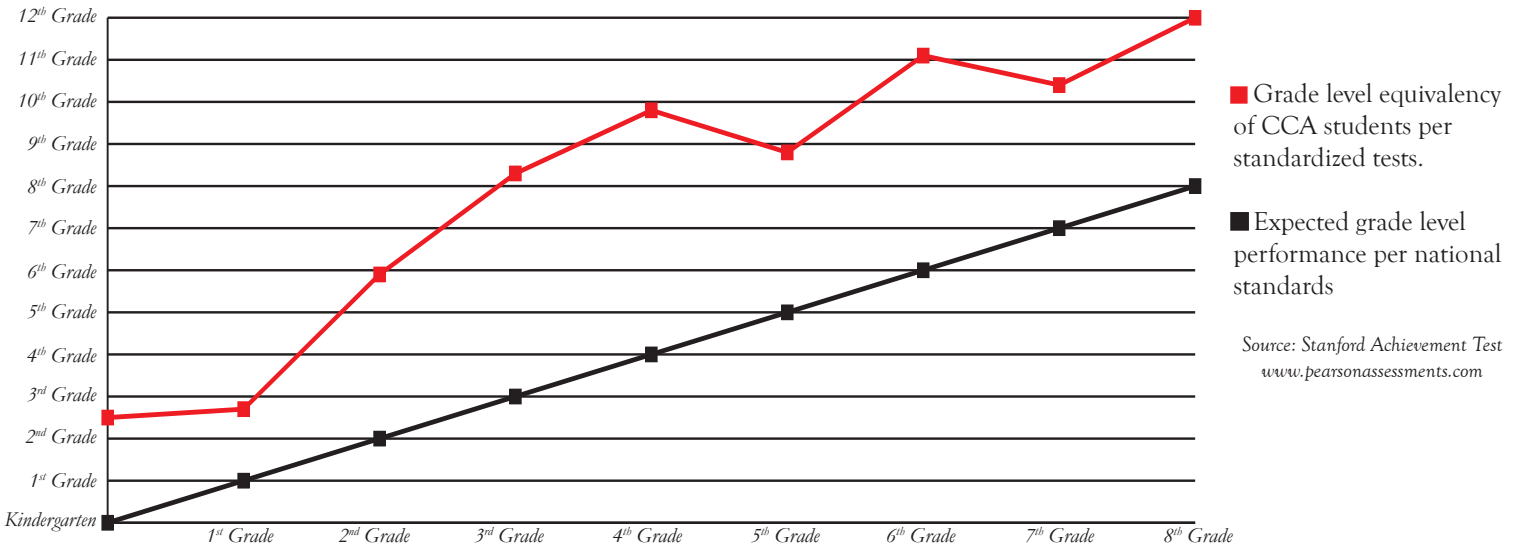
