**Application Fee** for New Students \$60

**Tuition Schedule**

- Full-Day Kindergarten \$4,240
- Grades 1-5 \$4,820
- Grades 6-8 \$5,030
- Grades 9-12 \$5,300

**Multi-Student Discount**

- Fourth (or more) Child Discount Tuition waived

**Payment Schedule**

- First Tuition Installment of \$250 per family due by **April 30**
- Second Tuition Installment of 10% of tuition balance due by **June 30**
- 10-month plan schedule begins in August and ends in May and is due by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month to avoid late fees.
- 12-month plan schedule begins in July and ends in June. This plan requires automatic bank drafts.
- Payments may be made by check or credit card (VISA and MasterCard) or bank draft.

**Payment Discount**

- There is a 3% tuition discount for paying a full year in advance on or before **June 30**.

**Tuition Insurance Plan**

- The Tuition Insurance Plan is mandatory for families on the 10 and 12-month plan and is due by **August 1**.
- Cost of the Tuition Insurance Plan is per student: \$125 for kindergarten, \$130 for Grades 1-5, \$135 for Grades 6-8, and \$145 for Grades 9-12.
- This program is optional for those families paying in full.
- Questions regarding the Tuition Insurance Plan may be directed to the Finance department.

**Extended Care**

- Available for Kindergarten through Grade 5: 6:30-7:30 AM and 2:45-5:30 PM
- Available for Grades 6-12: 6:30-7:15 AM and 2:45-5:30 PM
- \$4 per hour or \$100 per month for 1 child; \$175 per month for 2 children; and \$225 per month for 3 children if a contract is purchased in advance. Please contact the school office for further details. Payment of Extended Care charges **MUST** remain current to continue participation in the program.

**Please Note**

- Re-enrolling students have priority for classroom space before April 30. After April 30 enrollment is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- All financial commitments to CCA from previous years must be paid before re-enrollment will be accepted.
